Author: Solomon

- Asked God and granted wisdom (1 Kings 4: 29-31)
- According to 1 Kings 4:32: 3000 Proverbs, 1005 Songs
- Around 800 proverbs found in this book
- He sought out proverbs from others (Eccl. 12:9)
- Proverbs in 25-29 assembled by scribes of King Hezekiah

The Book of Proverbs

Time:

- Proverbs in Chapters I-24 written by 931 B.C.
- In his middle age years before his character declined
- Proverbs written 25-31 written 230 years later

Key word: Wisdom

- "The ability to live life skillfully"
- Provides detailed instructions for God's people to successfully deal with the practical affairs of everyday life
- God, parents, children, neighbors and governments

Foundational Facts:

- Chapters I-9 designed to create a felt need for wisdom
- Proverbs as a whole is designed to prevent and to remedy ungodly lifestyles

Foundational Facts:

- Product of the School of Israel
- Not an historical book
- Collection of topical statements expressing a general truth or rule of conduct (Maxim)
- Statements are concise and forcefully expressive (Pithy)

 - Prophets divine word and visions
